What do I need to bring to nursery every session?

- Nappies and wipes (if relevant)

Lunches

Children can either bring a healthy packed lunch in a named lunchbox or order a school dinner in the morning - there is a main or vegetarian option available each day at a cost of £1.80. We operate a 3 week rolling menu - copies can be obtained from the school office. Snacks - we provide fruit daily for the children.

How can I help my child?

Our biggest priority is that your child feels safe and happy at nursery and as parents you are doing a wonderful job of reassuring them that nursery is a fun place to be!

Each fortnight we will be sharing the nursery rhyme, maths song and poem that we are learning in class for you to practise at home with your child in order to support their learning at home. We will share these via dojo.

Forest School

Forest School will run every Monday morning (children should come dressed ready for forest) and every Thursday afternoon (please bring forest clothing in a bag) throughout the year as we want to experience the different seasons and weather that our climate has to offer! Please ensure that all children have wellies in school (which you can leave outside the classroom) and suitable, warm layers of clothing and waterproofs for Forest School. The children will need spare clothes to change into later on Mondays..

Please ensure that your notifications are turned on so that you can receive observations.
